Event: **Great Canadian Shoreline Cleanup**

When: 10:00 am to ~2:00 pm Saturday, September 20th, 2014

Getting there: Meet at the cleanup site at 10:00. Plan to stay until ~2:00. Map link: <https://goo.gl/maps/4Jqj5>
Google Maps says the Florence Lake Forestry Service Road is "Burma Street". Go to the end of Dewdney Trunk Road, turn left before you go over the dam, and follow the road 11 km. If you forget to check your odometer, there are 5 bridges before a fork. Take the right fork labeled Rocky Point Forestry Service Road. Site is 200 m down that spur. Driving time is ~1 hour (Google says 1 hr, 13 minutes).

What to Bring: Wear your necker! Water bottle if you wish. Wear appropriate clothing. (Scout events go on "rain or shine"; BE PREPARED!) Note that there are no washrooms at the site!
