



PATROL BOX CARE & FEEDING



10th COQUITLAM

Your Patrol Box contains all the cooking equipment you will need to camp. Some camps you may not need all of the items, so you can choose what to bring on the "Gear Selection Night" just before camp.

Please treat your Patrol Box with respect.

NEVER sit on it, as it is very easy to crack the lid.

Keep all of its contents clean and dry. Mould will grow and ruin equipment if there is any moisture left in the box.

If you have been assigned to take home your Patrol's Box after camp, follow the instructions below:

Take out all of the items in the box.

Wipe out (or wash if necessary) the inside and lid of Patrol Box.

Completely wash and dry all dishes, cutlery, utensils, knives, bowls, cups, pots, lids, cutting board, wash tub.

Wipe off stove & stove stand with wet cloth (do not wash in water).

Wipe off can opener with wet cloth (do not wash in water).

Dry out water carrier (do not wash).

Dry out oven mitts (do not wash).

Launder all cloth towels.

Look through your Consumeables:

J-cloth*
Paper towels
Pot scrubber
Garbage Bags
Dish soap (liquid)
Toilet paper
Duct tape
Twist ties
Matches
Fire starter (cubes or lint)
Hard Soap (for fire camp pots)
Salt & pepper & sugar

If you have used up an item or it is in bad shape:

make a list and give it to a Scouter so it can be replaced before the next camp.

*After each camp, always throw away a dirty J-Cloth and request a replacement.

MAKE SURE EVERY ITEM IS COMPLETELY DRY BEFORE RE-ASSEMBLING THE PATROL BOX.

Bring the clean, dry box to the next Scout meeting.
